FREE ADMISSION FOR ALL CLAY COUNTY STUDENTS

I am pleased to announce a new partnership agreement between the **Clay County Bank** and the Clay County Board of Education to **provide free admission for all Clay County Students** to all high school and middle school home athletic events. Here are the particulars:

- Free admission for Clay Co. students is provided for all home athletic events under the governance of the WV Secondary Schools Activities Commission (football, volleyball, basketball, wrestling, baseball, and softball).
- **All students** attending one of the six county schools, in grades pre-k through 12 are included.
- Students will be admitted by presenting a School ID card at the ticket gate.
- The ID card is **not valid at "away" events** or fund-raising events not

- **The card will be deactivated when the student becomes truant from school** (5 or more unexcused absences). The card can be reactivated when student attendance has been corrected.

The original idea for this partnership came from Clay County Bank President, Greg Gency. Mr. Gency is a former Clay County student athlete and the Bank is a long-time partner with Clay County Schools.

In order to make this happen, Clay County Bank is covering 80% of the cost of student admission. The Clay County Board of Education is covering the remaining 20%. Both organizations want to give back to the community and provide relief during the economic downturn.
